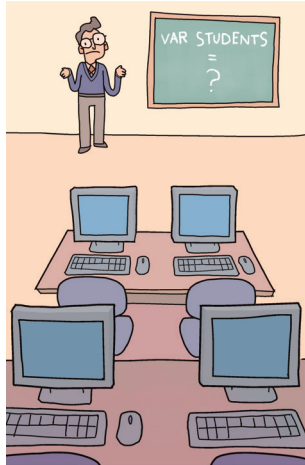


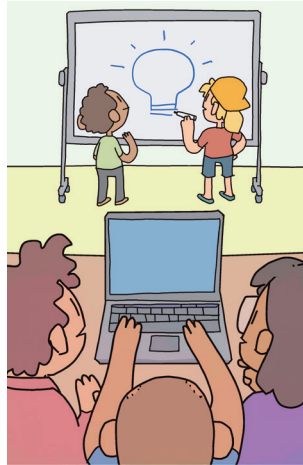
Increasing inclusive CS enrollment worldwide.



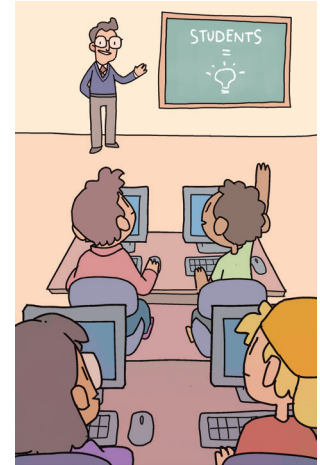
Over 20,000 students in the US, Canada, and Mexico started pursuing computer science after attending our programs.
